

What we did

- Focus groups with PHIs in BC and NS (n=11)
- Professional experiences & impact of SDH on health protection role
- Avoided "equity" terminology
- QDA: a priori & emerging themes







Barriers to compliance

Socioeconomic status

- Financial restrictions/cash flow
- Employee finances in job security

Cultural differences

- Expectations of PHIs/operator relationship
- Immigrants in new industry (food)

Language/Literacy

- Limited English language skills
- Low literacy/computer literacy

Stress

- Distraction
- Intensify other barriers

Geography

- Access to equipment, parts, expertise
- Food security in remote communities

Strategies to address barriers

Social strategies

- Building trust and being upfront
- Risk communication

Support strategies

- Creative use of funding; Referrals
- Avoid overwhelming

Language strategies

- Informal translators & nonverbal communication
- Borrowing print resources

Discretion

- Progressive enforcement and prioritization
- Consider context and competing risks

Organizational challenges

- Workload
- Staff turnover & lack of transition
- Prescriptive policies
- Lack of managerial support
- Silos: fragmentation & lack of collaboration
- Ambiguity about role & responsibility





Moving forward: Practice

Support EH workforce

- Strategies to recognize & respond to barriers
- Tools to mitigate barriers
- Intersectoral collaboration
- Public health system support
 - Adaptive policies
 - Articulate role & responsibility
 - PHI training and competencies

- Consider exploring provincial/regional differences

BCCDC

- Through an Equity Lens project
- Focus groups in all health authorities (Summer 2015 report)
